All my holidays are personally hosted by me, Helen Barr, often accompanied by my husband, Patrick. Bridge is as well organised as you would expect with a retired EBU TD in command. I'm affectionately known to my guests as "The Lady in Red" as I always wear red dresses so I can easily be spotted when needed! All the rules of bridge are obeyed, but no one is allowed to lose sight of my own favourite, law 74, so bridge is always fun! I have all mod cons, including electronic scoring with Bridgemate IIs, meaning results are ready within seconds of the last table finishing, and duplicated boards, with copies of the hands available at the end of play for either formal or informal discussion.

On all holidays generous prizes are awarded each session. They are licensed by the EBU and Master points are awarded at District Scale.

I invite all my guests to meet me in the bar each evening so I can buy them a pre-dinner drink.

All my Netherwood holidays are competitive bridge breaks which will appeal to anyone who plays at a duplicate bridge club. Bridge is played at the standard rate of 8 boards an hour and each session will last up to 3 hours. We play bridge mornings and evenings to allow guests a full afternoon to relax in the hotel or explore the surrounding area.
